Owner, director Gail Cappadona, CPDT-KA, pioneered the idea of "doggie day school," in the early '90's with her wildly successful, *Command Pawformance*, in Billerica, MA. Now, with a full-time, experienced instructor on board and a 3 acre facility at her disposal, Gail is excited to offer her unique program at *Cappa's Kennel*.

## Yuppy Puppy Package: For puppies 8-16 weeks of age

- Pre-School: 3x's per week for the first month
- Kindergarten: 2X's per week for the second month long semester. (Yuppy Puppy graduates will have completed 2 months of training at the academy).
  - <u>Day School Activities</u>: Heavy emphasis on socialization and engagement.
     Imprinting of leash manners, proper greeting (human and canine), basic commands (sit, down, come, wait, place or bed). Reinforcement of house breaking and crate training.
  - Hours: 8 am to 6 pm Monday-Friday (excluding Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve Day and New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day).
  - Cost: \$60 per day or buy a pack of 10 for \$50 a day (packages are good for 6 weeks from date of purchase). With completion of Pre-School and enrollment in Kindergarten, parents are invited to join us for *one* free "group" lesson per week.

### Middle School for the Adolescent: For puppies 16 weeks to 8 months of age

- <u>Day School Activities</u>: Engagement under distractions. Continued refinement
  of basic commands in public settings. Reinforcement of basic manners and
  socialization (canine and human). Free play, introductory agility, brain teaser
  games and supervised activities (Frisbee, Chuck-It, Find-It, Squishy Face)
- Hours: 8 am to 6 pm Monday-Friday (excluding Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve Day and New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day).
- Ocost: \$60 per day or buy a pack of 10 for \$50 a day (packages are good for 6 weeks from date of purchase). An additional discount of \$5.00 per day is offered for those dogs that have graduated from the Yuppy Puppy Program. Yuppy Puppy graduates are also offered *one* free group lesson per week.



## Adult School: For dogs 8 months and older

- Graduates of our Middle School and Yuppy Puppy Programs who would like to continue their education at the Academy with a pack of 10 sessions will continue to receive the additional \$5.00 discount (\$45.00 per day) and *two* free group lesson per week.
  - O Day School Activities: Refinement of obedience in public settings and with distractions—including off leash work if your dog is ready. Continued reinforcement of basic manners along with socialization (canine and human). Free play, agility, brain teaser games and general engagement activities (Frisbee, Chuck-It, Squishy Face).
  - Hours: 8 am to 6 pm Monday-Friday (excluding Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve Day and New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day).
  - Cost: \$60 per day or buy a pack of 10 for \$50 a day (the \$5.00 per day discount continues to apply for those dogs that attended the Yuppy Puppy and/or Middle School Programs.

Become a Cappa's Academy "Regular" Pack Member: When your dog becomes a Cappa's "Regular," he or she is not only able to spend the day with a pack filled with friends but continue to sharpen the commands he or she will need as a well behaved adult. Regulars have the added benefit of participating in weekly, off-leash, and obedience fueled field trips led by Jenn and/or Gail.

Why is it so important to keep coming back? When attended on a regular basis, day school is the perfect way to reinforce the behaviors you want most. Each and every day is filled with activities that teach, engage and entertain under the supervision of Gail's watchful eye.



# Individual Class & Fee Schedule:

#### **Initial Consultation:**

All of our private training and custom packages begin with an initial consultation lasting between 1.5-2 hours. During the consultation, we'll discuss your training and behavioral goals and issues. Before the meeting comes to a close, we'll formulate a plan for management and training that best suits both you and your dog. An initial consultation is necessary before any training can begin.
